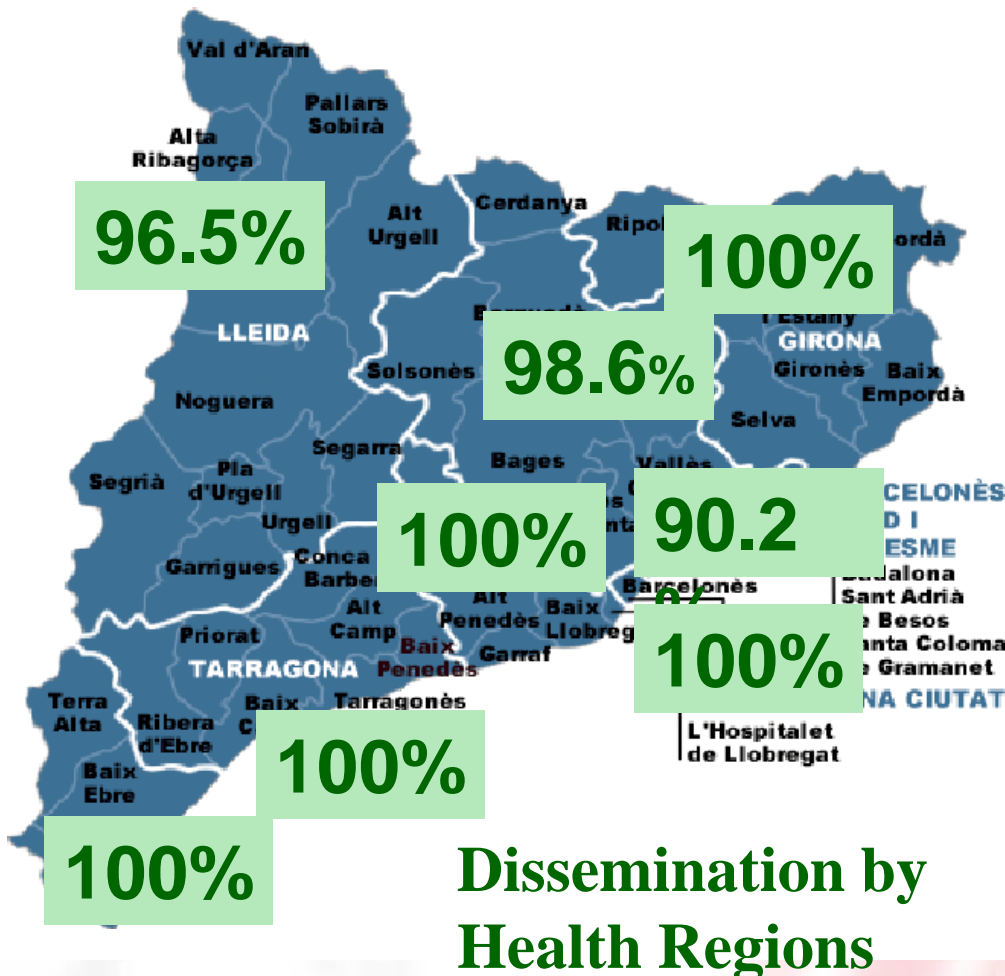

Background to the WHO Study

- Phase I (1983-1989)
 - Development of AUDIT screening tool
- Phase II (1985-1992)
 - RCT of effectiveness of brief interventions
- Phase III (1992-1998)
 - Marketing and training & support strategies to implement early alcohol interventions in PHC
- Phase IV (1999-2005)
 - Dissemination & wide implementation of early alcohol interventions in PHC

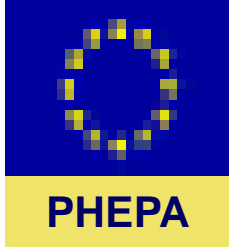
The “Beveu Menys” Program



December 2005:

- 84 trainers
- 340 courses made
- 98 % PHC centres
- 6311 professionals accredited
- 900.000 €
- BM Package: 8687 for PHC and 109 for trainers in Drug Treatment Centers (DTC)
- Bulletins: 23 numbers to 711 addresses (138 DTC)

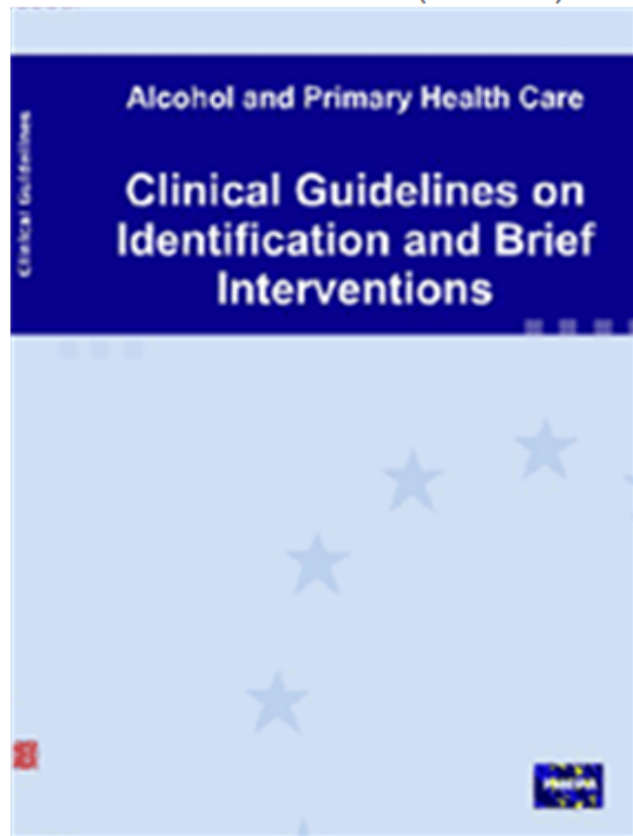

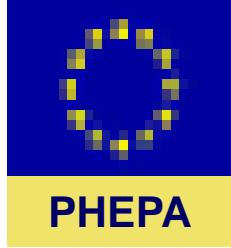

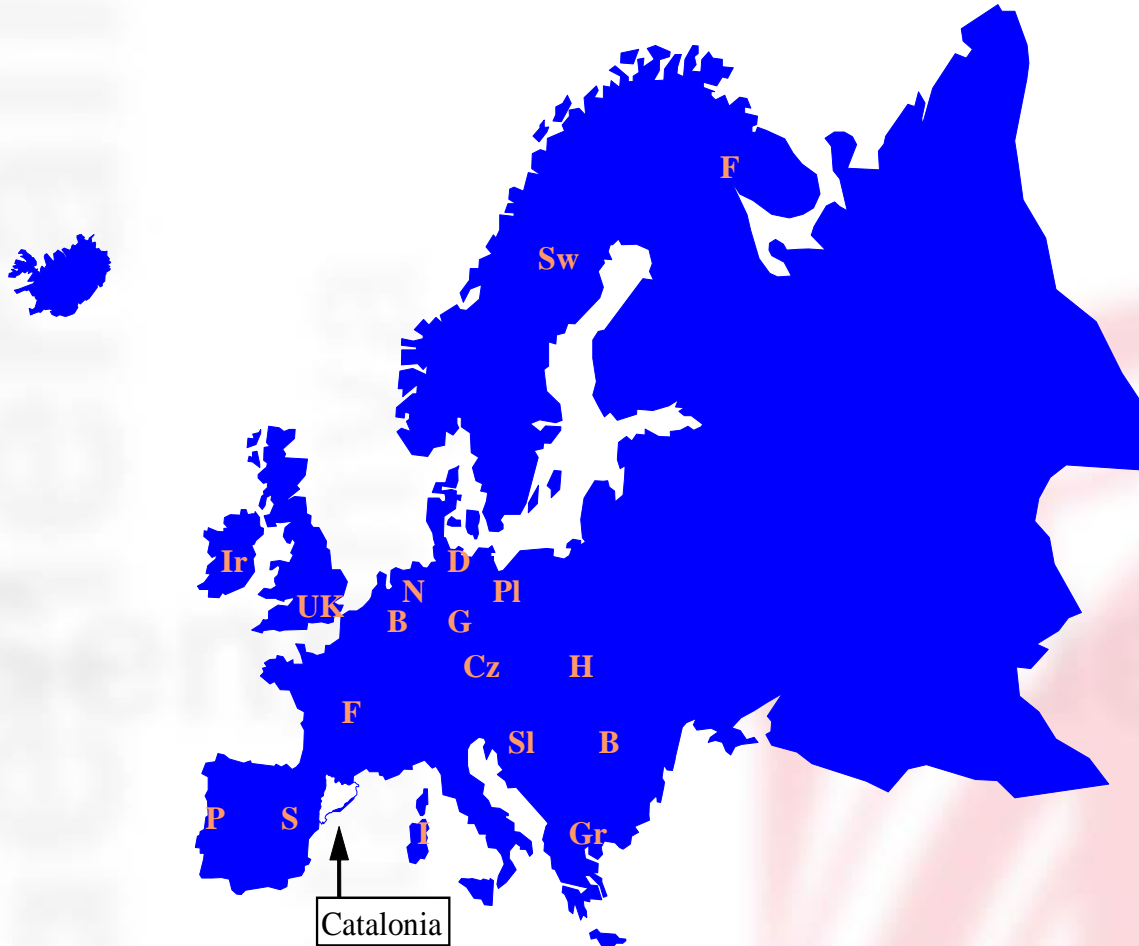

- The aim of the project is to improve the delivery of health care interventions by understanding how better to translate the results of clinical research into everyday clinical practice
- The research focusses on the implementation of IBI programmes for risky drinkers in PHC as a case study
